Working from the Lower East Side Ecology Center, our interns will help monitor the habitat preferences of organisms living below the surface of the East River. Interns will receive training/mentorship by professional scientists, while developing their own independent projects and using research-grade microscopes. They will also gain experience by serving as teaching assistants for our Saturday Science program. Modest stipend included.

Internship dates: Saturdays, 10:30-4:30
October 22nd through December 3rd (excluding 11/26)

Responsibilities:

- Participate in one day of training at the start of the internship
- Serve as a teaching assistant for 4 weeks of Saturday Science (family program)
- Be an enthusiastic leader and mentor
- Conduct research in our community laboratory under the guidance of a BioBus scientist
- Present your research findings to BioBus scientists

Requirements:

- Available for the full duration of the internship
- Current High School student (any grade)
- Have a genuine interest in scientific discovery
- Interest in working with younger children and cultivating scientific curiosity
- Prior completion of introductory biology courses is a plus
- Leadership experience is a plus
